



Pennsylvania the 29<sup>th</sup> of ye 9<sup>th</sup> mo<sup>th</sup> 1684

By virtue of a warrant bearing date ye— day of ye—mo<sup>th</sup> 1684. Surveyed unto John Barbridge fifty acres of land out of the Land formerly surveyed to Dunke Williams. Beginning at a pine tree standing on ye bank by Delaware River thence <sup>N.N.W</sup> by the land of Nehemiah Allin three hundred and twenty perches to a post for a corner thence E.N.E twenty five perches to another post for a corner thence S.S.E three hundred and twenty perches to a post for another corner and thence by Delaware River ye severall courses to the first mentioned pine tree Layed out for fifty acres of land.
