



Situate in Fairview (late Newbury) township York County containing fifty three acres fourteen perches and allowance of six pr. cent. Surveyed pr. contract on the 3rd day of November, 1831, on Warrant to Lewis Bush for 50 acs. dated 16th February, 1774 the whole of it included in a survey of 438 ac. 112 ps and allowance made on warrant to Joseph Glancey dated 1793. The dotted lines representing Glancey's survey (which is supposed to be patented) and the black lines representing the present survey and its relative location in Glancey's. Owned & occupied by Jacob Fisher, Samuel Fisher and Henry A. Testor's heirs.
