



The parts marked A and B are an interference of a tract of 176 acres, 32 perches, neat measure, surveyed for Nicholas Bittinger, and divided betwixt John Forry & Joseph Bittinger on the Pigeon Hills in Berwick Township. Part A contains 88 ac. 4 ps. neat, and Part B contains 88 ac. 28 ps. neat, the latter belongs to John Forry. Part C is a part of the same tract, now owned by John Bucher, Daniel Dietz, B. Allarwell, Joseph Hennler & others. The whole is patented. I am informed. Part C contains 37 ac. 120 ps. neat measure. Witness my hand, Sept 14th, 1837.
