



The part marked A, is an interference of a tract of 160 as and allowance granted by Patent dated 16th Novbr. 1749, to Robert Owings the elder, and now held and claimed by the Heirs of John Stigers, Dec'd, in Berwich Town P. A.A. is an interference of 9 acres conveyed by Joseph Storm to John Stigers by Deed dated 9th December, 1809, in Cowwago Town P. B. is an interference of 46 acres granted by warrant to Thomas Moore, and by Patent dated 20th July, 1764, to Thomas Armor, who conveyed to Owings 11th October, 1773, 26 acres thereof since conveyed by James McSherry, Trustee, under the will of Owings to Joseph Sneeringer, Senr. and now held by him, 22 acres conveyed by John Owings to John Stigers above named, in Cowwago Town P. C. is an interference of 200 as. 15 ps. granted by Patent under Maryland dated 8th October, 1733, and by Patent under Penn. dated 16th November, 1749, to Robert Owings the elder (father of Robert) and now held by Joseph Sneeringer, Senr. in Cowwago T. D. is an interference of about 75 acres held and claimed by Joseph Sneeringer, Senr. under a Deed from William Owings (the deed has been mislaid) in Cowwago T. The quantity of land held by J. Sneeringer in his tract is 285 as. 62 ps neat measure.

The do do J. Steigers was about 200 neat. E is an interference of 14 as neat measure granted and sold by Robert Owings dated 19th Oct. 1797, to Dudley Digges and now held Catherine Kuhn widow of Henry Kuhn Dec'd. F is an interference of a tract of 70 as. Patented by Penns to Thomas Armor dated 20th July, 1764. A deed was executed to Saml Lilly, Esqre, by Patrick Owings eldest son and heir at law of Wm. Owings for 145 as. 77 (including I think the 75 as. above mentioned of Jos. Sneeringer) dated 11th April, 1804, and a General Release from Robert Owings & other heirs of Robert Owings the elder was executed to Saml Lilly the present owner for 158 as. 110 ps neat, dated 26th Sept. 1797, Part in Cowwago & Mt Pleasant Townships. G is an interference of 3 as 50 ps sold by Wm. Owings to Ferdinand Shultz 16th June, 1791, part of a larger tract granted by Patent of Lord Baltimore to T. Owings dated 8th Oct. 1733. The Will of Thos. Owings dated 6th September, 1759, now held by Jas. Mc Barron & others. Witness my Hand. Aug 3d, 1837.
