

Situate in Fairview (late Newbury) township York County containing one hundred and two acres forty seven perches & allowance of Six Pr. Cent Surveyed Pr. contract on the 3rd day of November, 1831, on warrant to William Franklin dated 20th September, 1762, the whole of it included in a survey of 438 ac 112 prs & alce made on warrant to Joseph Glancy dated 1st August, 1793.

The dotted lines representing Glancy's survey (which is supposed to be patented) and the black lines representing the present survey and its location relative to Glancy's survey joining land late of William Baxter among the River Hills owned & occupied by Jacob M. Haldeman and Anthony Yinger's heirs.
