



In pursuance of the several Acts of Assembly directing the recovery of the principal and interest due to the Commonwealth from persons holding lands by virtue of locations or other office titles issued from or under the Proprietary Government and for other purposes, I have this day located & surveyed Warrant granted to Alexander McNair for 100 acs. joining his other land in the Manor of Mastie, on lands situate as aforesaid in Hamiltonbarrn (now Liberty.) Township, Adams County, and have found the interferences as represented in the enclosed diagram.
