



Deputy Surveyors Office, January 26th, 1827.

Sir, in obedience to your orders I have made out the above rough Diagram shewing the situation of the land surveyed on a warrant granted John Elder dated the 16th of April, 1763, called in the above No. 1. also shewing the situation of a tract said to be surveyed on a warrant of the same date called in the above No. 7. I have found in the office a warrant granted John Elder for two hundred acres of land situate in Fannet Township, Cumberland County dated the 19th of September, 1765, which from the boundaries called for in it, it may have been intended for the land surveyed on the warrant dated the 16th of April, 1763, called No 1. I have given the dates of the above surveys and also the dates of the different rights they were surveyed on as far as I could ascertain the same:
