Whereas in the year 1715 there was surveyed a Tract of 500 acres at Pequea then in the County of Chester now in Lancaster County for the use of our late Father and the same was sold by us to the late Andrew Campbell deced. who by his last Will devised the same amongst his three Sons, and whereas we have received information that there is a much greater quantity within the lines then is mentioned in the return of survey. These are therefore to authorize and require you to resurvey or cause to be resurveyed the said tract returned for 500 acres and after having so done and discovered the true quantity then to divide it amongst the three sons of the said Andrew Campbell according to their respective rights under the Will of their Father and make separate returns into the Secretary's Office, and for so doing this shall be your sufficient warrant &c.
