



A Draught of several Lots of Meadow Ground near Moyamensing, each part within the banks contains 11 a. & allowance for Dam Creek. But in order to draw releases &c each persons part is extended to Hollander's Creek, & every part described to contain 12 a be the same more or less.

Marsh, Swamp and Cripple situate
Surveyed on the 5th of October, 1736, to Thomas Lawrence, George McCall, Thomas Sobers, Dr. Thomas Greame, George Fitzwater & Peter Lloyd in pursuance of a Warrant dated the 13th of January, 1735-6 Containing 7 1/2 a & the said 7 1/2 a together with 1/2 an acre in the said Patent separately described having been drained, cleared and improved at the joint expence of the said Company and in the banking and draining thereof a small strip by Hollander's Creek being left without the banks for the support and defence of the same containing about 6 a. the remaining part within the banks was divided into six equal parts or dividends & one of the said parts allotted to each of the persons aforesaid and to be held in severalty each part containing 11 acres, the limits and bounds of each of the sd parts to join on Hollander's Creek.
