" We approve of giving Stille as much Marsh in ye place mentiond in ye draft, as ye half of ye Road,
 " ye points wth in my fence & y^t he proposes to live together with ye a piece for ye Dam amounts to, but
 " I believe ye P^e of Land included in y^t he is to have granted him is part of ye 2 1/4 As, if so he is not
 " to have his own Point of fast land & 2 1/4 As. besides, let him have just as much Marsh added to
 " ye P^e of fast land as ye fast land he conveys to us amounts to on a Pepper Corn Acknowledgmt
 " ye Marsh on ye side belongs to us not to me
