A.D. 1753 (for 100 a. adjoining Elias Reed over the Blue Hills) By Geo. Rattn.

To the Honble the Board of Property

The date of the original Survey of the above tract can now no longer be ascertained by the line trees, in as much,
as it is nearly all cleared land and the report is in the neighbourhood, that all the papers, draughts &c. of the original
Survey are lost or purposely destroyed, in as much as the present owners now hold it under a warrant granted to
Michael Ehro, dated 7th of Jan'y, 1790, which Survey under Ehro's warrant covers Redler's Wt. and includes also the
adjoining part laid down, as above by courses & distances. Ehro's Wt. was patented by William Hogeman. Patent
to him dated 23 Feb'y, 1818 in Patent Book H. Vm 15. Page 338.

The original improvement on Redler's tract is or was commenced some where about 60 years ago.
The Red Lines, including the yellow inside, contains the Suy. of Ehro's Wt.
