The above draught is that of the original survey of David McFlory and of which a survey appears to have been made in pursuance of an Order of the 3d of Ap! 1769, No. 166 agreeable to the papers in the office of the deputy Surveyor of Armstrong county, and by the same it appears that this same survey of David McFlory was again surveyed to Alexander Clark on the 20th day of October 1786 in pursuance of a warrant granted to the same dated the 24th day of August A.D. 1786, which tract of land is now in possession of John Waller whose claim is derived from that of Alexander Clark aforesaid. The above represented survey of David McFlory contains two hundred and forty eight acres of land situate in Allegheny township Armstrong county bounded by Crooked creelt and lands surveyed to Thomas or James Burd, Bernard Macho and Ann Curswell, and in pursuance of a contract made with the board of Property dated the 19th of October A.D. 1827, I do hereby make a return of the same
