

By virtue of a warrant from the Commission<sup>rs</sup> bearing date the 13<sup>th</sup> of the 11<sup>th</sup> mo. 1703. Resurvey'd unto Griffith Jones of the County of Philadelphia merc<sup>t</sup>: Eight acres of land within the Liberties of Philadelphia being the original Purchase of Mary Southworth alias Mollenex. Beginning at a corner post of the land late John Barnes & Sarah Fuller. Thence east north east Twenty eight perches and a halfe by the Land late Tho. Ebbel. Thence south south east by vacant land forty four perches to a post. Thence west south west by the land of Robert Grimaway Twenty eight perches & a halfe to another post for a corner. Thence north north west by said Barnes & Fullers land forty four perches to the first mentioned place of beginning. Executed 14 Feb. 1703/4.
