



The dotted lines and the letters A B C & D. in the above diagram represent a survey made to Benjamin Elliott a return whereof I herewith enclose. It will be seen that the survey has been made on the ground called for by the location and also that the land has been previously surveyed to William Maxwell and Charles Campbell. The survey of Maxwell was made the 25th January 1790 on Warrant of the 12 June 1785 and that of Campbell on the 23d January, 1790, on Warrant of the 3d April, 1786. These two tracts are in the occupancy of James Campbell whose improvement is included within the survey made to Elliott. I am informed that Charles Campbell Father of James Campbell is the owner and that the lands are patented but ^{not} having had an opportunity of seeing Genl. Campbell I cannot be certain as to that.

It does not appear that Genl. Campbell or any other person is now, or ever has claimed under the title in the name of Benjamin Elliott.
