Whereas the Commissioners of Property. By their warrant dated the 30th day of July 1712 Granted to Isaac Norris Esq: Ten acres of Libertie land in the Right of William Lovel, and by their ^{other} Warrt dated the 25th day of ye first month 1715. Required me to survey to John Falconar & Andrew Hamilton sixty acres of ~~land~~ land in ye Liberties of Philadelphia which right of sixty acres was conveyed by Andrew Hamilton & Gilbert Falconar Brother & Attorney to ye ^{5th} Jn^o Falconar. ~~by~~ ^{further} To ye sd Isaac Norris by deeds dated ye 22nd & 23rd days of Aprill 1715. And whereas the ^{5th} Commis^{ee} By their warrant dated the 16th day of Jan² in ye year 1726 Granted to ye ^{5th} Isaac Norris. Thirty six acres of Libertie land in ^{right} of Charles Marshall Jonah Smith & Compe^{ee}. And the ^{5th} Commis^{ee} having also Granted by their warrt dated ye 10th day of Jan² in ye year 1721. Granted to Jno. Davies twenty acres of land in ^{the} right of William Kent's Purchase of 1250 acres. The right of w^{ch} twenty acres is now invested in ye ^{5th} Isaac Norris ~~etc~~. Now this may certifie That in pursuance of ~~the~~ warrant and rights above mentioned. I have survey'd and laid out severall ^{acres} of land wthin the Northern Liberties as follows That is to say I did on the first day of 9th 1715. Lay out unto NIch^o Waln assignee of ye ^{5th} Isaac Norris twenty acres of land. And I did on ye 23rd day of Aprill 1723. Survey a piece of land Beginning at a corn^e post at a corn^e of Thomas Gallowhills land & running by othe^r land of ye ^{5th} Isaac Norris south south east one hundred & five perches to a post. Then by Job Goodsons land west south west sixty three perches to a post therr N.N.W by the ^{5th} Goodsons land ~~ninty~~ two perches then on ye same course thirteen perches by Tho. Gallowhills land to a post then by another line of ye ^{5th} Gallowhills land E. N. E. sixty three perches to the place of Beginning containing forty acres And I did on the 20th day of 8th 1727 Survey a ~~piece~~ piece of land Beginning &c. [here ye 34 acres bounds] And on the same 20th day of 8th I did further survey & lay out another piece of land Beg &c. [here ye 26 acres] And for the full compleating of all ye above mentioned warrants & rights. I did on the — day — [here ye 6 acres by ye rock on Sculkill.]
