Resurvey it by careful Chainmen and divide and cutt out of it two hundred acres with due allowance to each of the last mentioned persons by such <sup>Division</sup> Lines as have already been run and best agree with their several respective Deeds and throw off the overplus in any regular pieces where they shall desire it provided that they have not cutt the timber off from those pieces. Only reserve to the Proprietor a few acres adjoining on Skuykill Falls & have a regard to the School house built on the upper part of it endeavouring to accommodate y<sup>e</sup> matter among those concerned in the Building of it. This is what they request and I hope they will assist thee.
