



In pursuance of the several Acts of Assembly directing the recovery of the principal and interest due to the Commonwealth from persons holding lands by virtue of locations or other office titles issued from or under the proprietary Government and by the authority of the Board of Property, I have this 9th day of May 1828 surveyed the above described tract of three hundred and twenty seven acres & ninety six perches and allowance of six percent on Conemaugh joining Michael Wurley situate in Conemaugh Township Indiana County By virtue of a location granted to Martin Schneider on the 3d of April, 1769, No. 294.
