



Pursuant to contract with the Members of the Board of Property of the State of Pennsylvania dated the first of Novr. 1827 & the authority therein, the above tract of land was surveyed & calculated by virtue of APPN. No 283 granted by the Proprietary Government to Devereaux Smith, Contain - Three hundred acres & alls situate in the Proprietary Manor on the North East side of the Monongahela River, including all of Farm No 1, said to contain 375 acres 57 1/2 P. & alls as laid down upon the plan of sd. Manor, the angle with the dotted lines bordered with gamboge show the balance of the tract after Smith's claim is taken off. The Heirs of Mr. Shearwicke have possession of the premises that was Smith's & have valuable improvements thereon
