



Marsh Swamp & Gripple Situate &c. Surveyed on the 5th of October 1736 to T.L. G.M. T.S. DE T.G. G.F. & P.L. in Pursu of a warrant dated the 13th of Jan^y 1735-6 contain^g 71 1/2^a & the s^d 71 1/2 together with 1/2 an acre in the said Patent separately described having been drained cleared & improved at the Joint expence of the s^d Company & in the banking & draining thereof a small strip by Hollanders Creek being left without the banks for the support & defence of the same contain^g about 6 as the remain^g part within the banks was divided into six equal parts or dividends & one of the s^d parts allotted to each of the persons afores^d to be held in severally each part contain^g 11 acres the limits & bounds of each of the s^d parts to join on Hollanders Creek is bounded as followeth That is to say, Thomas Lawrence's part Begins &c.

A draught of several lots of Meadow ground near Moyamensing, each part within the banks contains 11^{ac} & Allow^d for Darr Creek.

But in order to draw releases &c. each persons part is extended to Hollanders Creek & every part described to contain about 12 acres be the same more or less.
