



The Red notes are agreeably to the old surveys, when Robt Thorn & Wm Shearer were disputing the rights of the land, the notes in black ink are according to the surveys alluded to below.

Robert Thomns Order No. 3093 was executed but I cannot learn anything of John Martin or John Peters.

Surveyed to Wm. Shearer (no date) pr. Order No. 613 and returned for Wm. Schooley now Argus McDonald pr Order No 2983: Also surveyed or attempted to be surveyed in 1769 and 1770 for Robert Adams & Thos Shain in Rt of Wm. Shearer & Henry Schryock (250 as) and again on 14 January 1785 pr same Order (No. 639)

Surveyed in 1770 to Wm. Shearer & Henry Shryock is now owned by Joseph Thornton of Brownsville the upper part of the 250 acres tract is owned by Solomon G Krepps, and Wm Cook & other Joseph Crawford & others, Luzerne township

Surveyed to Reese Cadwallader in Oct'r, 1784 pr Warrant of 29 Sept. 1784 includes part of Robert Thomns survey and all his improvement this part of this land is now covered by the Borough of Bridgeport, the remainder belongs to John Krepps and others.
