



Situate in Fawn township in the County of York containing as above set forth 361 a 151 perches & the usual allowance. Located on the 16 day of June 1831 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Alexander McCandless for 250 as dated the 25 day of September 1746 and by virtue of the Contract entered into with the Board of Property Report. The above is the same as was surveyed on a Warrant of resurvey dated the 5 of March, 1768, directing to divide the Land of Alexander McCandless Dec'd according to his Will. It is now owned and occupied by John Neaper to whom a Patent was granted for the same dated 14 of April 1812
