



In pursuance of a Contract of the 1st of Novr. 1827, with the Members of the Board of Property of the State of Penn'a & the authority therein stated, there was survey'd & calculated by virtue of Application No. 2658 granted from the Proprietary Government unto William Baird the 3d of Apl. 1769, the above described tract of land, situate in Plum & Vargales Townships, the Creek being the division line of the two townships. Containing three hundred acres & the alls of Six P. Ct. Gabriel Heister Jr. Esqr. Surv. Genl. Pennsylv. Robt. Beatty  
 March 13th, 1828.

- B. Interferes with the survey of John Mc Masters. Patented. (including the mouth of Heidlers Run)

- D. Interferes with the survey of John Mc Masters in right of John Reed. Surveyed upon warrant and patented.
