



Draft of a Tract of Land situate in Antrim township Franklin County Containing three hundred & forty three acres forty three perches & allowance of six percent for Roads &c Surveyed the 28th day of November 1829 agreeable to lines said to have been run by Thomas Cookson formerly D.S. (on a Warrant granted William Maxwell for 150 as of land joining to a tract of 150 as granted by Samuel Blunston to Simeon Evans & lying between Edward Michels & Evan Shelys on a Spring that sinks & rising again runs into Cornococheague dated the 16th of December 1737.) In pursuance of a Contract with the Board of Property for carrying into effect the several Acts of Assembly relating to Proprietary Rights &c
