Report For John Rowen &c. The tract No 1 was surveyed on Orders No. 3543 & 2969 unto Arthur St. Clair Esq who conveyed it to Daniel St. Clair to whom a patent was granted bearing date 18th of Oct 1780. Nos. 3543 & 2969 Patented. No 2 was surveyed on a Warrant to Robert Dickey dated 31st of March 1796. Returned. Contains 250 as. Pat'd. No 3 was surveyed on a warrant granted to Robert Dickey dated February 21st, 1786. 400 as. 168 prs. Pat'd. For Alexander Irwin. No. 1 same as No. 1 for the other. No. 2 & 3 the same as above. No. 4 was warranted to Arthur McMichael dated 6th of September 1787 and it also includes a part of Jeremiah Lochtery's claim but that survey or Patent could not be found as it had been sold at Sheriff's sale in Bedford County, Pa. and did not know exactly in whose name it was returned. Note the surveys of Robert Dickey & Gen St. Clair interfere as will be perceived by examining Alexander Irwin's survey. Arthur McMichael - Pat'd
