Report. The above tract is covered by the following Office Rights to wit: 113a. 130ps. part thereof marked A. and 12a. 20ps. & al. marked B. were survey'd 26 June 1787 in two parts, on a Warrant to William McKnight dated 21 February 1787 and held under said title 7 acres 158 ps. & al. represented by dotted figure C. was included with D. in a survey of 40a. 13ps. made 6 May 1768 on a Warrant to William McKnight dated 1 Sept. 1766. Note. The above is rather presumed to be the location of John McKnight's warrant from the circumstances of him being said to have lived at the place marked Mansion & the land recognized as that of John McKnight.
