

A connected Draught of 6 separate pieces of Land situate in Little Britain Township in the County of Lancaster Containing together 286 acres 40 perches and allowance of
six p cent for Roads &c.
No. 1 - Contains 102⁰ 22⁰ and allowance (Original Survey 95⁰ and allowance) Surveyed the 2nd day of December 1752 on Warrant Granted to George Churchman dated 8th of August 1751.
No. 2 - Contains 101⁰ 20⁰ and allowance of six p cent Being part of a Tract of 312⁰ and allowance Surveyed the 5th day of October A.D. 1750 in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to James Patterson dated
the 11th day of April 1749.
No. 3 - Contains 34⁰ 93⁰ and allowance Being part of a Tract of 177⁰ and allowance Surveyed 2nd Day of January A.D. 1750 in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to Alexander Foster Dated the 17th of April 1749.
No. 4 - Contains 27⁰ 157⁰ and allowance Surveyed the 19th day of December A.D. 1831 in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to William Miley for 27⁰ Dated the 5th day of December A.D. 1831.
No. 5 - Contains 11⁰ 73⁰ and allowance Surveyed in pursuance of an Application Granted to James Patterson No. 2015 Dated 27th Day of October A.D. 1766.
No. 6 - Contains 8⁰ 155⁰ and allowance Surveyed 19th day of December A.D. 1831 in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to W^m Miley for 8⁰ Dated the 20th day of October A.D. 1831.
Surveyed for William Miley the above Described piece of Land November 23rd A.D. 1836
