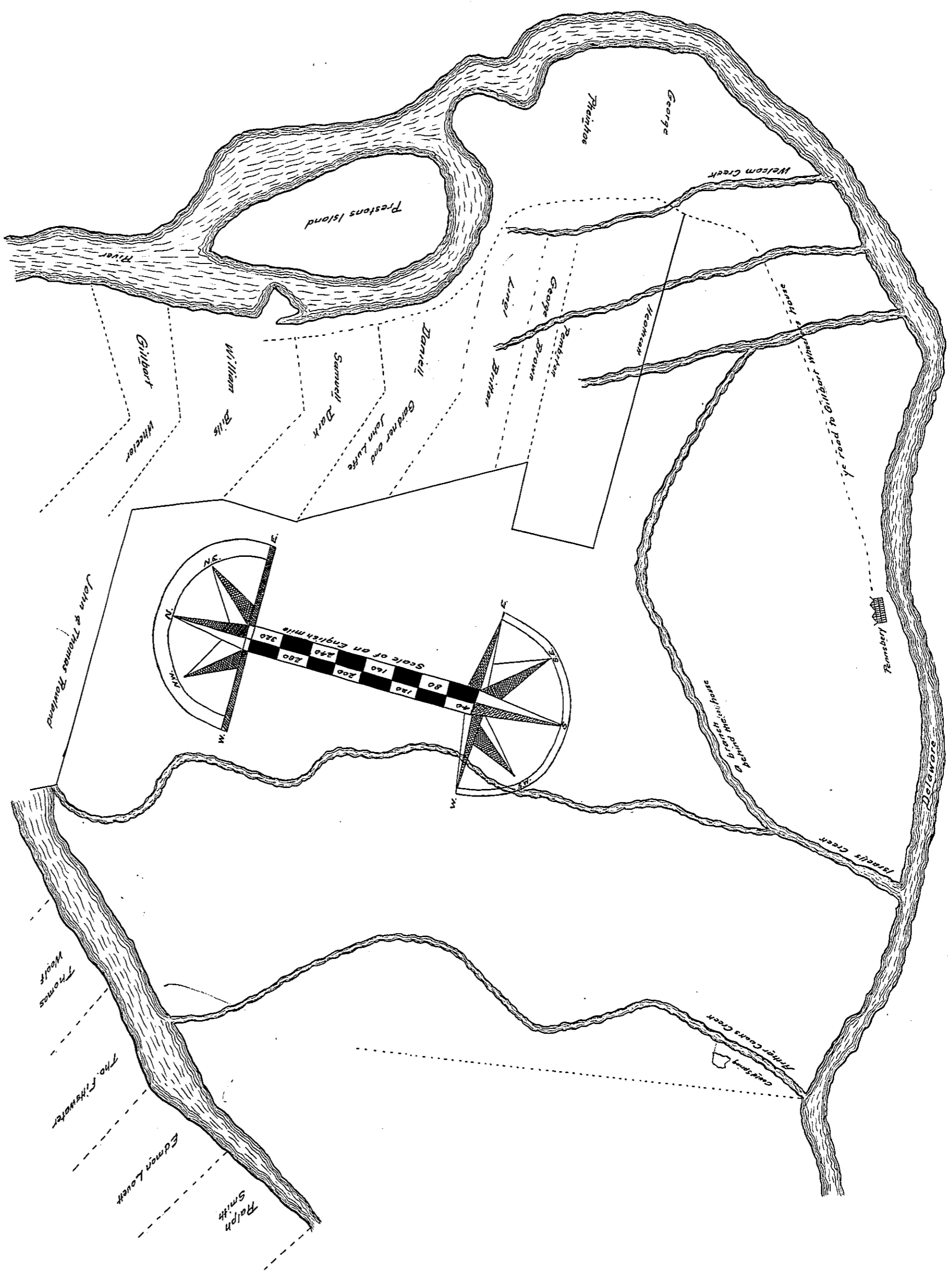

The Governor's warrant of Pennsylvania in the County of Bucks Containing at first Laying out 6831 acres of Land - out of which was laid out by the Governor's order to his own servants the balance of the great swamp 1283 acres: viz To Ralph Smith - 370 acres
To Thomas Rowland - 342
To The Woolf - 270
To Edmon Lovel - 336
L288.

and by order of the Governor at his departure going for England, was laid out to George Heckford 200 acres and after by the Commissioners warrant was laid out 300 to Heckford: I find there was laid out by Elizabeth Bennet adjoining to The Woolf's land of the part of the great swamp and to other parts was laid out a certain number of acres unknown to me for I did not lay it out nor the 100 acres of Bennet's I find remaining left to the Manager here unlaid out including Cooks land with it 6345 acres.
