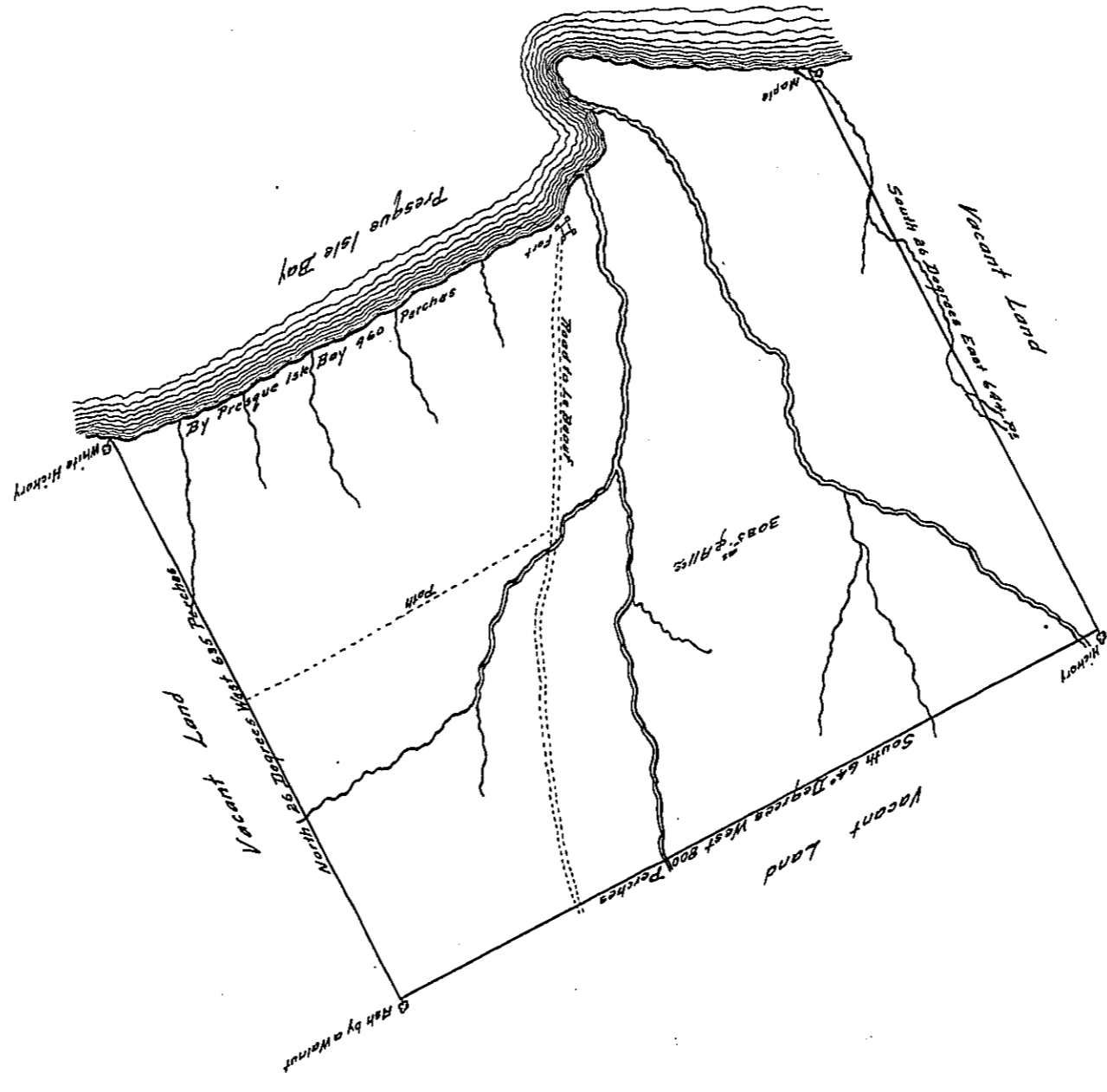

In pursuance of a Resolve of the General Assembly dated the 24th of March 1789 and by order of the Surveyor General, was surveyed on the 27th 28th & 29th days of July A.D. 1789 the Above described Tract of Land, Situate at Presque Isle formed by Lake Erie including the old French Fort, containing three thousand & thirty five acres & the usual allowance of six P. Cent for Roads. &c.
