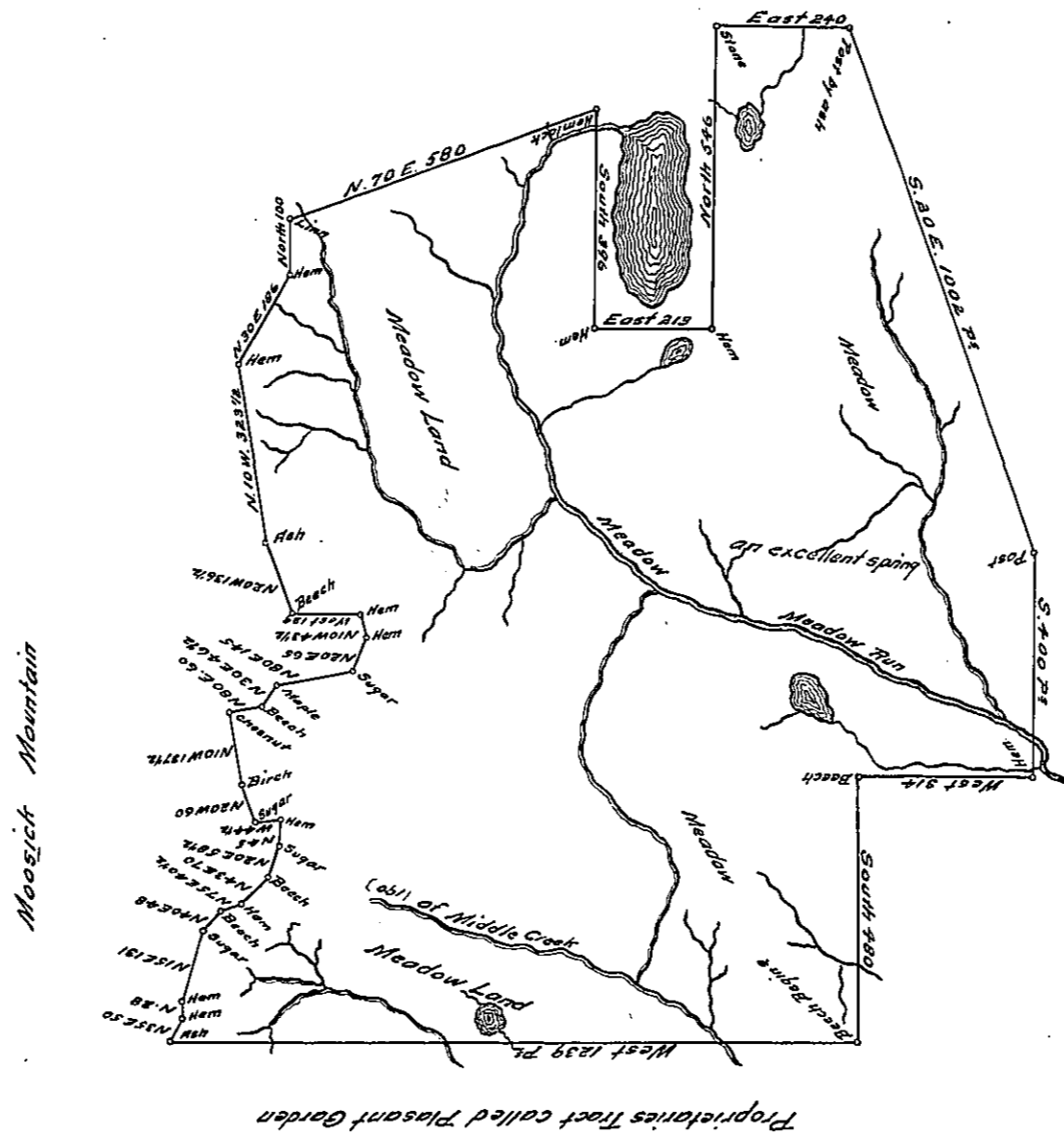

By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 31st day of May 1776 and surveyed from the 6th to the 12th of July 1776 to the Honourable the Proprietaries the above described tract of land Situate on the Waters of Lechawaxsin creek on the Head Waters of Big Middle creek in Northampton County containing Eleven thousand five hundred and twenty six acres three quarters and the allowance of Six p cent &c.
