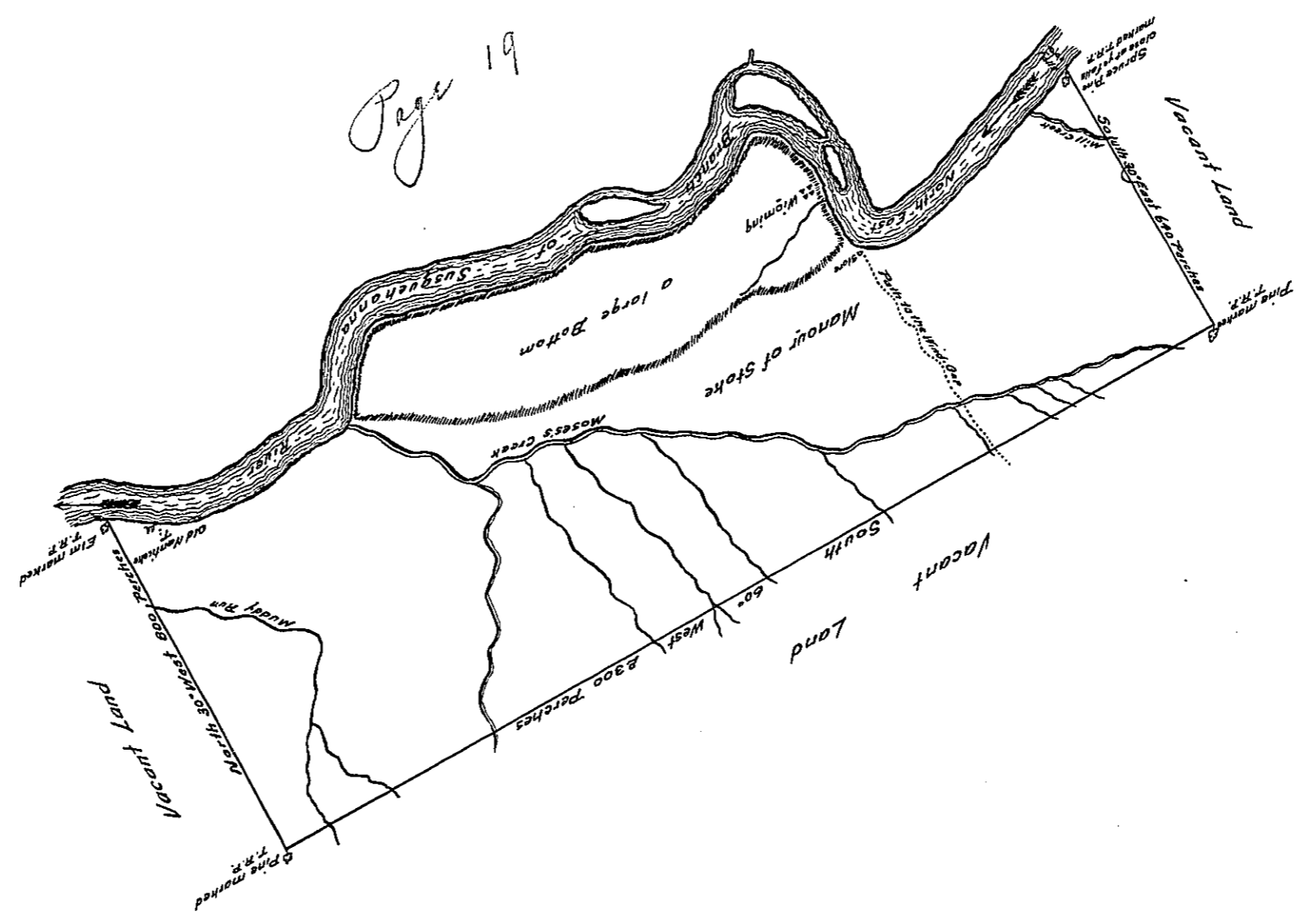

By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 29<sup>th</sup> Day of October 1768, Surveyed the 9<sup>th</sup> &c Days of December 1768, to the use of the Honorable the Proprietaries of the Province of Pennsylvania, the above described Tract of Land, situate at Wiaming, on the South East Side of the North East Branch of Susquehanna River, containing Nine thousand eight hundred Acres and Allowance of Six Per Cent

In Testimony, That the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly, approved the 16th day of February A.D. 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of the said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this seventeenth day of April A.D. 1912.
