



In pursuance of a Warrant dated the 20th. day of April A.D. 1831 Granted to John Ashbaugh was Surveyed on the 16th of May 1831 as appears from Warrant, and Draught filed in the office and marks upon the ground containing three hundred and fifty six acres one hundred and fifty four perches and allowance of Six percent &c. Situate in (now) Kiskaminctas Township Armstrong County "Signed" Robert Richards D.S.

And now to Wit on the 23rd. day of May 1839 Surveyed to Jacob M: Cartney that part of the above Survey including the Letter A. containing one hundred and Eighty one acre thirty perches and allowance &c. Situate in Kiskaminctas Township Armstrong County. To Jacob Solady Esqr. } Jonathan E. Meredith D.S.

N.B. That part of the above Survey including the Letter B. has been already patented to Jacob M: Cartney J. E. Meredith D.S.
