



This Survey accepted to include the Return of 200 acre previously made on Peter Fair's Mar. & accepted the 4th of Feby. 1830 and also the 52 1/2 acre for which a warrant was taken by John Fair dated the 3d. of Feby. 1830

Surveyed to Peter Fair on the 31st. March 1787 the above described tract containing Two hundred and fifty two acre and an half of an acre & allowance of Six percent. Situate on a small spring on the South side of Blacklick Creek about half a mile from S^c Creek joining land of Mr. Smith on the South East & on a small path leading from Samuel Dicksons to Brakins Mill in Westmoreland (now Indiana) County By Warrant of the 13th of November 1786 as appears from papers remaining on file in my office.
