



Situate in Samar Township Centre County Containing one hundred and thirty seven Acres thirty five perches and allowance of six per Cent &c. Surveyed the 28th day of March 1821. In pursuance of a warrant granted to William Allison dated the 28th day of February AD 1821. The improvements on the above described tract of land at the time of making the survey, consisted of a Cabin House and Barn, about forty Acres of Cleared Land, first improved in the Month of March 1802 Wm Allison and his family actually residing on the same, and says that they have resided there on since the year 1809.
