

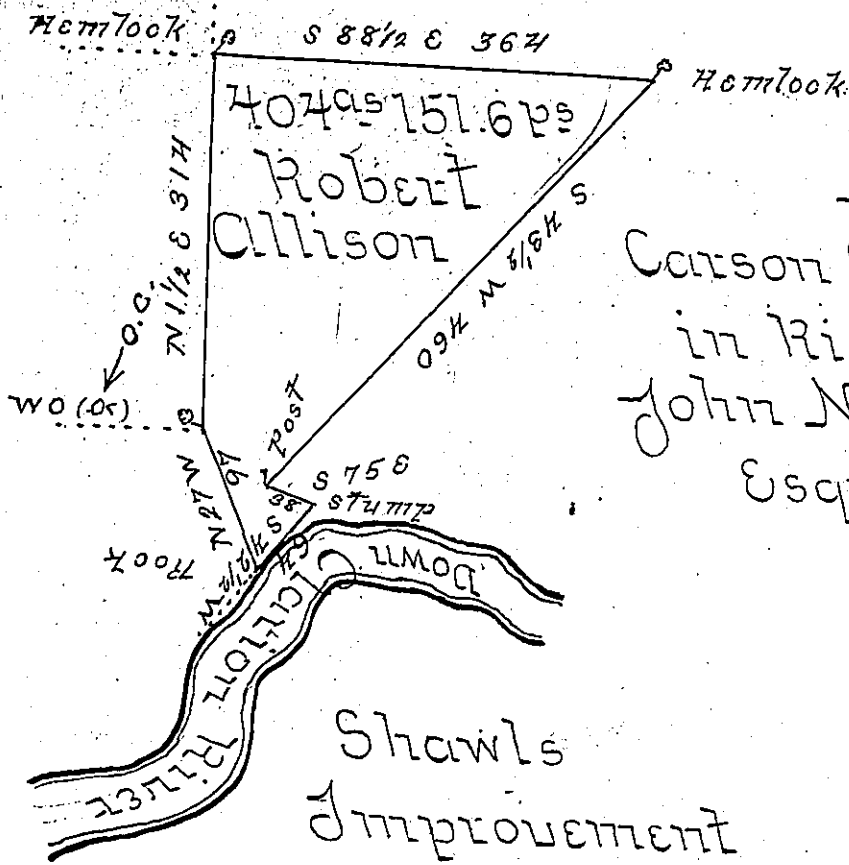

By Virtue of a Warrant dated the Eleventh day of July A.D. 1851 and to me directed, I surveyed the thirteenth day of August A.D. 1851 for Robert Allison, the above described Tract of Land containing four hundred & four acres & one hundred & fifty one & sixth tenths perches and allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. Situate on Clarion River in the last purchase made of the Indians East of the Allegheny River & Conewango Creek in Heath Township, in the County of Jefferson (now Forest County) and State of Pennsylvania.
