



Situate in Monroe Township Bedford County containing 209 acres 37 perches & Allowance of 6 per cent for roads &c. being composed of three surveys as follows No. 1 containing 160 acres & allowance surveyed on a warrant granted in the name of Jeremiah Alters for 150 acres dated the 12<sup>th</sup> of March 1856. No. 2 contains 21 acres & perches & allowance surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted in the name of Benjamin H. Carpenter for 21 acres dated the 11<sup>th</sup> of November 1850. and No. 3 containing 115 acres 29. surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted in the name of Jeremiah Alters for 115 acres dated the 15<sup>th</sup> of May 1852.
