


James C. Fisher's Land



Situate on the waters of Black Lick on East Side of Laurel Hill surveyed on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of May 1794 by George Woods D.S. on a Warrant dated on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of Feb<sup>r</sup> 1794. Then Bedford now Cambria Co. Susquehanna Township, Resurveyed on the 22<sup>nd</sup> & 23<sup>rd</sup> of April 1836 the original lines found correct & contains as per draft with all
