



The above Described tract of Land (marked A) was surveyed to Thomas Allison on the 29th June 1811 By warrant of the 16th April 1811 - and contained three Hundred and sixty four acres and four tenths of an acre (as appears from papers in my office) that part (marked B) was surveyed to Thomas Allison in addition to the former survey on the 1st 1st Day of February 1823 and contains thirty six acres and seven tenths of an acre - in all four Hundred and one acres and one tenth of an acre and the usual allowance of six Percent - By virtue of the aforesaid warrant - Situate on the waters of Twolick Creek in Indiana County Center township. Samuel Cochran Esqr S G Meek Kelly W S P S the warrant was endorsed executed as I find it among the papers - But I am informed that there was no return made of the survey M K

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this twenty fourth day of August 1903.
