



By Virtue of a Warrant Dated at Philadelphia on the 2^d Day of February Anno 1746 granted to Andrew Ashbager. The above described Tract of Land Situate in Lowhill Township in the County of Northampton and Province of Pennsylvania Containing one hundred and Twenty Eight Acres and 100 Perches of Land together with the usual Allowance at six per cent for Roads was Surveyed for Yost Friess on the 5th Day of September 1753.
