



In pursuance of the Settlement of ~~Paul~~ Robert Pollock was surveyed on the 12th day of September 1839 for Elijah Anderson. The above described tract of land situate in Venango Township Crawford County on the west side of French creek, Containing three hundred thirty six acres one hundred and thirty seven perches (336^{ac} 137^{ps} & all) and the allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. It being the same tract of land surveyed on the 11th day of June 1795 for Paul Wilcott in pursuance of his Improvement bearing date the 24th day of March 1795 as per entry in the survey book in my office, page 49. Known as the Dunn tract.
