



Situate in Carroll Township York County containing Twenty four acres, one hundred and forty three perches & allowance of six percent. Surveyed May 7<sup>th</sup> 1841. In pursuance of a Warrant for Fifty five acres granted to Daniel Ahl dated 30<sup>th</sup> Jan'y 1841. This land is unimproved, & for a length of time called Stevens's Land. Recently a Patent has been discovered in the name of John Nitchman which was understood to be a Patent for the land sold and conveyed by John Nitchman Junr to Abraham Dehuff embracing the above survey, and the Figure A B C D. represented by the dotted lines. The Fig. A B E D. is also Patented in the name of Andrew Mumper, and in the possession of Henry Kraub & others
