Being part of a larger Tract of Land originally surveyed by William Mathews late D.S. on the 24th of the 2^d month 1766 for Joseph Allison. In pursuance of a Warrant for 150° granted to him bearing date the 17th day of May A.D. 1763. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger Tract of Land on the 4th day of May A.D 1802. And now at the request of the Present owner John Gemmil I am desired to make a return of the draught the 28th day of June. Anno Domini 1809
