Situate in Paradise Township in the County of York. Containing as above set forth 81<sup>as</sup> & 30 perches and allowance. Being part of a larger tract of 314<sup>as</sup> and allowance which was originally surveyed on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of May 1756 by George Stevenson late D.S. for John Ermil alias Armwell. In pursuance of a Warrant for 100<sup>as</sup> granted to the said John Armwell bearing date the 19<sup>th</sup> day of May 1752. And afterwards to-wit on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of April 1766. The above resurveyed and divided off from the said larger Tract by Lewis Lewis D.S. under Charles Lukens - late D.S. and now at the request of the present owner Caleb Briechner. I am desired to make Return of the Draught as calculated, examined and corrected the 22<sup>d</sup> day of August Anno Domini 1809.
