The above resurveyed and divided off from the said larger Tract by Lewis Lewis D.S under Charles Lukens late D.S. and now at the request of the present owner Caleb Briechner I am desired to make Return of the Draught as calculated, examined and corrected the 22nd day of August Anno Domini 1809.
