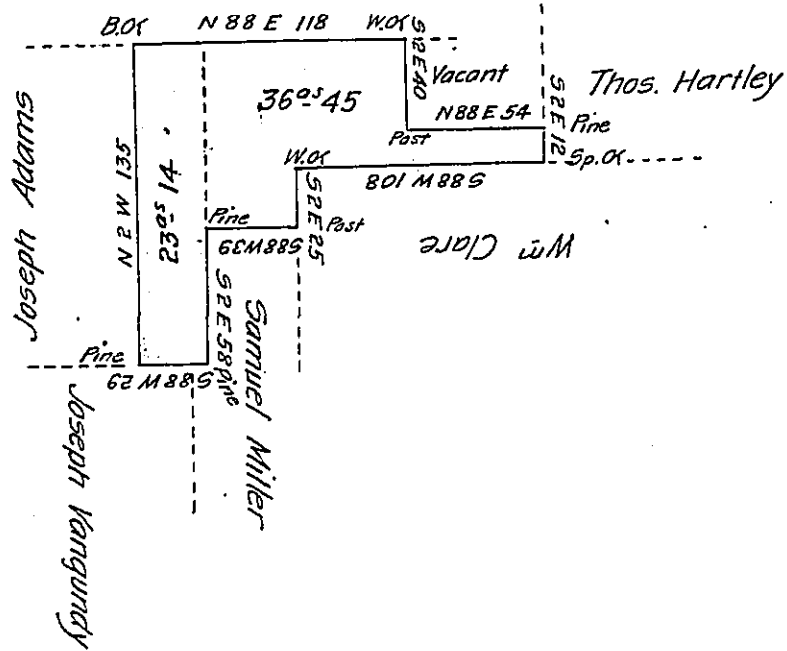


Jacob Kuntz
