



A draught of fifty one acres and three perches of land with 6 P. Cent. for roads Situate in Fermanagh township in Mifflin county which appears to have been surveyed in part 20th October 1786 in pursuance of a warrant to Hugh McElroy dated 28th February 1786 Resurveyed 26th June 1805 including an addition, shewn to the south of the dotted line in the above draught (which was untill then vacant and unappropriated) made pursuant to an order of the board of property, granted to Andrew Mitchel dated 16th February 1803.
