We the Commissioners for adjusting the Claims to Unpatented lands in the Counties of Monongahalea, Yohoganea & Ohio do hereby certify that William Bonner is intitled to four hundred Acres of Land in the County of Ohio on Buffeloe Creek to include his settlement made in the year 1777. Given under our hands at Cox^s fort the twenty second day February 1780 in the fourth year of the Commonwealth.
