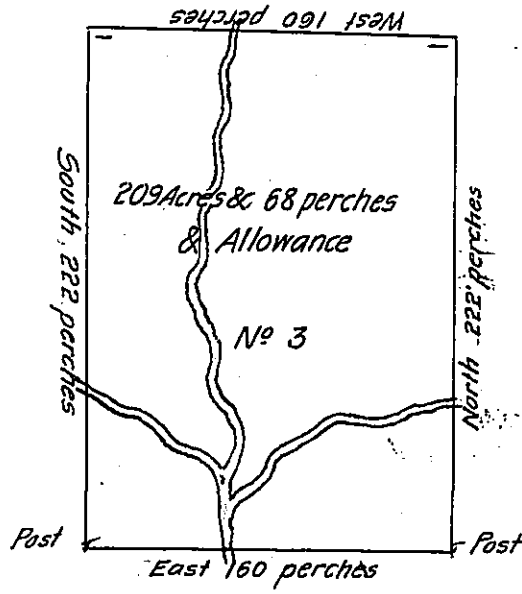

In pursuance of an Act of Assembly passed the 12<sup>th</sup> day of March 1783 for the sale of certain lands therein mentioned, and by Virtue of a Commission to me directed under the hand and Seal of Office of John Lukens Esq<sup>r</sup> Surveyor General for the State of Pennsylvania bearing date at Philad<sup>a</sup> the 14<sup>th</sup> day of August 1783 the above tract of Land Containing two hundred and nine acres and sixty eight perches & allowance of 6 Pr. Cent for Roads &c. was surveyed on the 31<sup>st</sup> day of May 1785 by
