



In pursuance of an Act of Assembly passed the 12th day of March 1785 for the sale of certain lands therein mentioned and by virtue of a Commission under the hand and Seal of Office of John Lukens Esq^r. Surveyor General for the State of Penn^a to me directed bearing date at Philadelphia the 14th day of August 1783 the above tract of land containing two hundred acres and allowance of 6 P.
