



In pursuance of an Act of Assembly passed y<sup>e</sup> 12<sup>th</sup> day of March 1783 for the sale of certain lands therein mentioned & by virtue of a Comission under the hand and Seal of Office of John Lukens Esq<sup>r</sup> Surveyor General for the State of Pens<sup>a</sup> to me directed bearing date at Philad<sup>a</sup> the 14<sup>th</sup> day of August 1783 the above tract of land containing two hundred acres and Allowance of Six Pr Cent for roads &c.<sup>a</sup> was surveyed on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of June 1785 by
