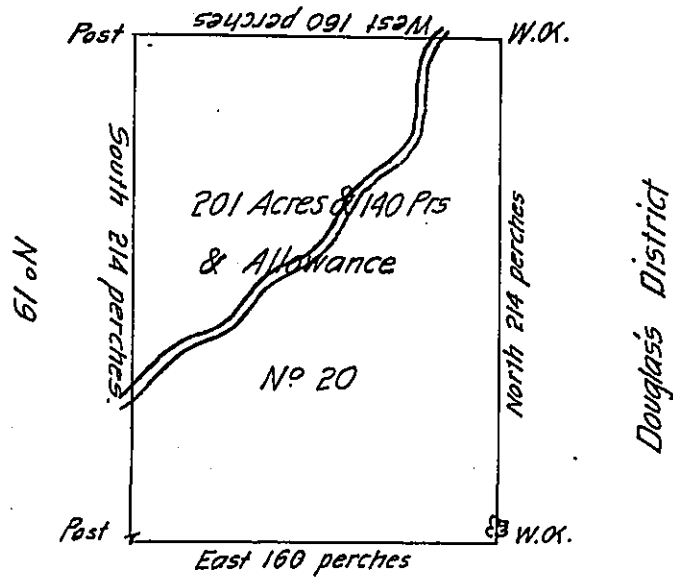

In pursuance of an Act of Assembly passed the 12<sup>h</sup> day of March 1783 for the sale of certain lands therein mentioned & by virtue of a Commission under the hand and seal of Office of John Lukens Esq<sup>r</sup> Surveyor General for the State of Penn<sup>a</sup> to me directed bearing date the 14<sup>h</sup> day of August 1783 the above tract of land containing two hundred and one acres and one hundred and forty perches and allowance of 6 P. Cent. for roads &c<sup>a</sup> was surveyed on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of June 1785 by
